The Great Need

THE GREAT MISCONCEPTION

People consider Kenya to be a largely Christian country surrounded by Muslim nations. In truth, Kenya is mired in false teachings, syncretism, and witchcraft. Christianity in Kenya has missed the mark of the Gospel, with charismatics and the prosperity gospel dominating the teaching. Sadly, the gospel is being lost in the noise of syncretistic religions.

At the heart of Kenya is its capital city, Nairobi. With over forty different tribes living together in this rapidly growing city, Nairobi is central not only to Kenya but to most of the nations of East Africa, many of which are dominated by Islam. If the gospel is going to penetrate and flourish in this part of the world, it will only happen as sound-minded churches are established. Therefore, there must be a priority on establishing a sound-minded, model church out of which we can do training. In the context of that model church, we will be able to train others to go out and plant like-minded churches. This is the mandate of 2 Timothy 2:2: "what you have heard from me in the presence of many witnesses entrust to faithful men, who will be able to teach others also."





THE PLAN

The key to this spiritual battle will be establishing healthy churches that can clearly proclaim the gospel and defend the truth. This is why Grace Community Bible Church (GCBC) was planted in the heart of Nairobi in the fall of 2020. Nairobi is a city of pilgrims who travel there from all over East Africa seeking better jobs and better lives. The vision of Grace Community Bible Church is to reach these tribes by preaching and teaching sound doctrine among the people, transforming them from physical pilgrims to spiritual pilgrims.

Through clear and consistent expository preaching and teaching, Grace Community Bible Church seeks to provide a place of fellowship and growth to reclaim the true and right doctrine of the New Testament Church. Mark Ndinyo desires to add qualified and trained men to the pastoral team at GCBC, and our family intends to come alongside him in this and answer to call for laborers for the harvest.

SENDING CHURCH

Our sending church is Faith Community Church in Woodstock, GA. This church body trained Kyle up, in seminary and afterwards, and is considered our "home church". Faith Community Church will not only provide the largest portion of our funding, but they will support us through ongoing prayer, counsel, oversight, accountablility, and short-term missions projects in Kenya.

PRIMARY PARTNERS

Our Primary Partners are those churches who will come alongside Faith Community by praying, investing significant financial contributions, and participating in short-term missions projects to strengthen our efforts in Kenya. These churches are foundational to our successful ministry at Grace Community Bible Church. Our goal is to have at least eight churches as primary partners that contribute up to 80% of our budget.

SECONDARY PARTNERS

Our Secondary Partners are those churches and individuals who pray, send, and give on a smaller scale. This commitment is made with a desire to see our ministry established and to help our prayer base and finance smaller projects in order to see our ministry flourish. Our goal is to have at least ten churches or individuals who come alongside our Primary Partners to fill in any gaps in funding.

PRAYER PARTNERS

Prayer Partners are those churches that are interested in building up our prayer base and possibly sending volunteers to help support and encourage our family as we serve overseas.
